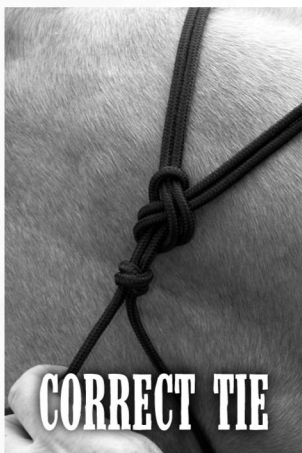


HAND-TIED ROPE HALTER

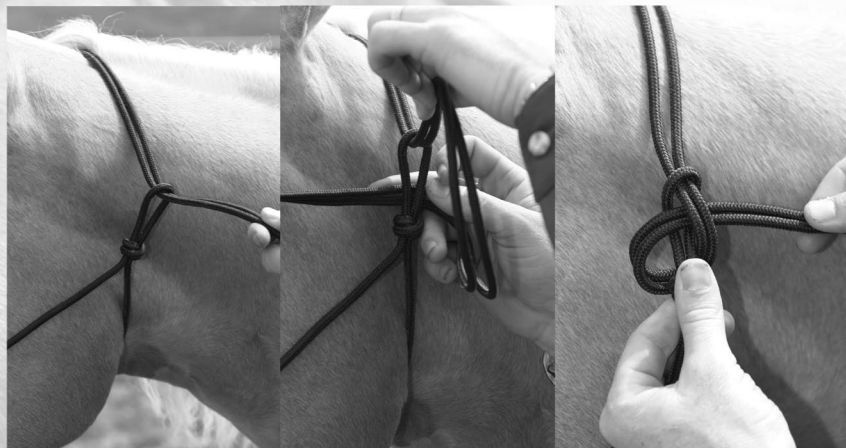


Hand-Tied Rope Halter with Pressure Point Knots

Sized for Newborn, Foal,
Weanling, Yearling, Average,
Large, or Draft



CLINTON'S NO.1 TRAINING TOOL



STEP 1

Position the halter on the horse's head, bring the end through the loop from the back.

STEP 2

Wrap the end behind and below the top of the loop.

STEP 3

Pull the end through the hole and tighten the knot.

It is important to bring the end around the loop, behind and below to prevent the halter from slipping. See image to the far left for sample of a correctly tied rope halter.
